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

The Position: Vice Provost for Enrollment Management

Reporting to the Provost in a newly created strategic role, the Vice Provost for Enrollment Management will serve as the key representative for student enrollment, retention and degree management at Clemson University. This is a high impact position that will help shape the quality and diversity of the current and future undergraduate and graduate student body at Clemson University.

The Vice Provost will build on the national recruitment and admissions reputation of Clemson University and provide strategic vision to attract and retain a diverse, high quality student body. The Vice Provost will oversee analysis, marketing, recruiting, outreach, admissions, and financial aid for freshmen and transfer students to shape the undergraduate class, and partner with the university's colleges to ensure the recruitment and retention goals are aligned with institutional goals.

The Vice Provost for Enrollment Management is responsible for overseeing the leadership, budgets, technology, and operations of the offices of Admissions and Student Financial Aid, as well as other units to strategically lead the various aspects of enrollment management. As part of his/her duties, the inaugural Vice Provost for Enrollment Management will: serve as a key member of the Provost's leadership team and shape the future directions for enrollment management goals; oversee the office of summer school, the Bridge to Clemson Program, and related programs; collaborate with the academic colleges on the development of short-range and long-range enrollment goals; and collaborate with other campus entities (e.g., the Honors College, the Graduate School, the Office of Global Engagement, Student Affairs, the Chief Diversity Officer, Institutional Effectiveness and Assessment, and Development).

Offices which will report to the Vice Provost of Enrollment Management include:

1. Admissions
2. Student Financial Aid
3. Registrar
4. The Bridge Program and Transfer Transition and Success Services
5. Academic Success Center
6. Freshman Academic Programs, Early Success Program and Freshman Summer Reading Program
7. National Scholars Program
8. Summer School

Furthermore, the Vice Provost will be well-versed on national trends and issues facing higher education, be fully up-to-date on federal and state requirements, and active with national professional activities. This individual will represent Clemson University to a wide array of constituents, including students, parents, alumni, and high school and college counselors, and provide national and international visibility for Clemson University. The Vice Provost will be a resource and advisor for Clemson's senior administration.

The successful candidate will have the following attributes:

- strong leadership and communication abilities;
- a proven track record of working effectively across campus;
- knowledge of national trends in recruitment, retention, financial aid and state/federal rules and regulations;
- commitment to strategic planning and assessment;
- strong data analysis and quantitative skills
- keen marketing skills and an ability to work collaboratively with multiple constituents.

Qualifications

- This senior-level administrative position requires a minimum of a master's degree in a related area (PhD preferred) and at least 5 years of increasingly responsible executive-level experience in enrollment management or a related unit at a highly selective higher education institution.

- Broad knowledge of University academic policy, administrative structure, academic governance, and service delivery.
- Evidence of leadership in developing and advancing diversity.
- Evidence of inclusive and decisive leadership in higher education.
- Seven or more years of administrative and budget experience.

Additional Desired Characteristics and Abilities

- Ability to manage competing priorities, deadlines, and projects simultaneously.
- Demonstrated ability to facilitate partnerships among academic programs and other divisions of the university faculty, students, and community constituents.
- Integrity, confidence, enthusiasm, initiative, and flexibility.
- Clear ability to think both long range and strategically; a demonstrated vision and creativity; and the ability to inspire others to active engagement in a common enterprise.
- Can communicate effectively to multiple constituencies, including University professionals, the academic community and the public.
- Collaborative leadership style in exercising leadership within the framework of shared governance.
- High energy and a collaborative management style; enjoys interaction and collaboration; friendly and open with all constituents
